

#### APPLICATION FOR COUNSELOR- IN -TRAINING PROGRAM

Teens, ages 14-16, who exhibit leadership potential and have the desire to work in a camp setting, may be selected to participate in this program. An *application and interview* are required for consideration.

### CIT Schedule 2023

The CIT program is conducted in one 4-week session July 10 - August 4, 2022. The first two weeks will consist of classroom training and workshops. The last couple of weeks CIT's will be with a senior counselor working towards their goals and getting hands-on experience. A complete schedule will be given to you on the first day of camp.

## **Counselor- in -Training Program**

The CIT program is heavily oriented to an understanding of all aspects of the camp operation. The CITs learn in a classroom setting and through hands-on activities. Emphasis is placed on team building, leadership skills, working with children and a comprehensive awareness of the Camp Ketcha program. CIT's will learn behavioral training, risk management, skills to motivate campers, learn marketable skills, job application workshop, interviewing workshop, job shadow a variety of staff and eventually lead a group under the supervision of a senior counselor. The CIT's will also work on an individual project throughout the course of the program and determine goals with the CIT director to guide them through the process. The culmination of the program will be an overnight camping experience. The group size will be limited.

# **Counselor- in -Training Fees**

The cost for the CIT program is \$550 for the four-week program and \$20 for the required annual registration fee.

## **Counselor- in-Training Application Process**

- 1. Counselor in Training Applicant (not your parent/guardian) needs to fill out the CIT application
- 2. Parent/Guardian needs to complete online registration including the required forms and necessary deposits of \$50 per week and the \$20 annual registration fee.
- 3. The Camp Director or CIT Counselor will contact you to schedule an interview.
- 4. Once your interview is complete we email you a letter regarding the status of your application. If you are accepted into the program it will include a list of what to bring. If you have not been accepted into the program the letter will include a way to indicate how your refund should be processed.
- 5. If you are accepted into the program, you will be considered a camper and receive all camp communications. The CIT group always meets in the center of the circle on the upper field.
- 6. Once the program is complete you will receive a certificate of completion and a final evaluation.
